"We needed to add additional redundancy to ensure our systems would continue to operate in the event of hardware failure. Our firewall was outdated, and the VPN solution was not working reliably for our users. Our core and edge switches could not provide the throughput needed for data requests across our network. It's hard to estimate the time involved in 'fixing' the problems, but when things aren't functioning as a unified system it can easily eat up all your available time. We can now be proactive in our network management instead of reacting to the problem of the day."
